

PLAYER PENALTY RESOLUTION PROCEDURE

Send-Offs

Referees will not confiscate the pass of a player sent off or a coach dismissed. All passes will be returned to the appropriate person with each team following the match.

Suspensions

Section 1. Red Card Ejections

A player is suspended for at least one game if the player receives a red card (ejection) or 2 yellow cards in the same game that results in a red card (ejection). A coach will be suspended for at least one game if the coach is removed from the game by the referee.

Section 2. Additional Game Suspensions

A player or coach may be suspended for more than one game if the Discipline Coordinator considers the offense one that warrants more than a one-game suspension.

Section 3. Notification of Cards Issued

The Discipline Coordinator will notify the appropriate State Association of all cards given.

Procedure

A player and the player's coach, along with an assigned referee, must fill out one "Player Penalty Verification sheet" for each game that the player is penalized as a result of the red card penalty. A player may assume that the penalty is the standard one game suspension unless the coach or travel coordinator of the player is notified by the Discipline Coordinator that additional penalty time must be served. RED CARDS FOR VIOLENT BEHAVIOR WILL BE A MINIMUM TWO GAME PENALTY.

The player will be reinstated only after the "Player Penalty Verification sheets" have been completed and turned in to the Discipline Coordinator. The form is available on the web site (Coaches Information - Online Forms)
